The 2019 season has started with the harvest in the north of the country of mandarins such as Satsuma Okitsu, Satsuma Owari and Oronules. Autumn has began with exceptional weather conditions as sunny and fresh days with absence of abundant rainfall.

Their harvest will be finished this week while the Clementines and Lemons will be starting. Weather forecasts shows auspicious weather having cooler temperatures with sporadic and reasonable rainfall.

Forecasts for the 2019 harvest

Summer water conditions have been great allowing a good set and initial growth of the fruits. Thats why in URUD'OR S.A we estimate a volumen of normal export fruit.

From the sanitary point of view, we also foresee a year without surprises as long as the climatic conditions are maintained. The phytosanitary treatment programs were carried out without problems.

The year began with a cautious market in terms of orders. However, we expect "clean markets" for the moments of our arrivals at the different destinations. We have important commercial challenges for 2019: new receivers, further develop the Chinese market, prepare for the destinations of Southeast Asia once the Uruguayan health authorities finish preparing the required protocols and implement a corrective program based on - our export trajectory - that allows a better arrival and defend the internal quality and the colour of our fruit.

On April 4 and 5, two citrus farms of the south were audited by the Certifying Body (LSQA) in order to renew the GLOBAL G.A.P. protocol version 5.1.

It stands out the commitment assumed in the continuous improvement as part of the work culture of all those involved, which begins in the farms with its members producers, managers, operators, continues with the packing house staff that process fruit for the group and finishes in those who have the responsibility to organize marketing abroad.

In June, the low or not of MRL (maximum residue limit) for Imazalil will be voted in Brussels by the "Standing Committee on Plants, Animals, Food and Feed Section Phytopharmaceuticals - Pesticide Residues"

Currently at the packing houses that process the fruit of URUD'OR S.A it is a key fungicide of post-harvest to control Penicillium digitatum the fungus that causes major losses worldwide.

That is why from here we are already working throughtout alternatives in case of possible reduction of the MRL from 5ppm to 0.01ppm.

is a key post harvest fungicide in the current global system.
