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


At this stage of the year where farewell parties and meetings are approaching, it is time to make a balance of what happened in 2019, of the proposed goals and difficulties. With this objective we meet Directors, members of the Commercial, Administrative - Financial and Technical Departments of URUD'OR together with producers and their technicians.

We are pleased to make you part of the following news: in this year URUD'OR S.A. was the largest exporter of citrus fruit in Uruguay with 37% of exports, being the largest exported volume of the last 5 years with 38,600 tons.

Likewise, as planned at the beginning of the year, we conducted export experiences to Southeast Asia with shipments to China and India. We hope to continue generating experience to consolidate in these markets.

In general terms, the exterior and interior quality of mandarins, lemons and oranges was consistent with those expected achieving a good performance of the product at destination. We will continue working to generate information at the national level to continue improving the condition of the varieties that require it. In the next year we hope to increase the volumes of new mandarins such as Oronules, Nankou, Tango and Orri.

This training had as an specific objective to know tools available nowadays for the control of Geotricum sp beacuse of the change in the Maximum Residue Limit (MRL) of propiconazol near in the future. As well as getting in knowlegde of more innocuous alternatives, leaving less residues of phytosanitary products in the fruit and contributing to obtain a product with the characteristics demanded by the markets.



Quality Management System



In mid-October, technicians from the Technical Department of URUD'OR and AGRISUR have been trained to implement the update of GLOBAL GAP version 5.2.

We begin, as planned and like previous years, to perform internal inspections of the farms. We plan to finish them at the end of January, following the requirements of GLOBAL GAP version 5.2 and GRASP 1.3. We will also continue to carry out internal audits regarding the BRC protocol, version 8 according to plan, at the AZUCITRUS S.A and AGRISUR C.A.R.L packing plants.




