Shipment Status

To date, a large part of the season has already passed and we are a few weeks away from completing shipments to the European Union with Valencias.

In several markets, URUD'OR stood out against fruit from other origins in terms of condition and external quality. The integrated management of the fruit from the orchard to the client is essential given the increasing restriction to use post-harvest phytosanitary products and thus comply with the new regulations of the receiving countries and clients.

Taking care of each link in the chain from production to transport is essential to achieve success; without forgetting the favorable climate that accompanied us in the harvest. The new strategy in overseas shipments at low temperatures has been one of the keys to achieving a firm product, with practically no stains and rotteness. Aspects such as compliance with the weekly shipping programs and the technical specifications of each client, favorably influence the results achieved.

WEATHER CONDITIONS



In the May-June-July quarter, the country had below normal rainfall except for the littoral region where accumulated rainfall was normal for this time of the year.



The average temperature did not register anomalous variations for this time of year.



For the August-September-October quarter, the country is divided into two regions: For the southeast, accumulated rainfall is expected below normal with an average temperature of the time. For the rest of the country there is a probability of standard rains and average temperatures below normal.

New Technology: Crop Netting

A characteristic of the Uruguayan citrus fruit is the presence of seeds in several varieties of mandarins. This disadvantage is becoming more and more relevant. URUD'OR, together with its associated producers, have set out to continue looking for solutions. One of them is to cover the crop with net during flowering and thus avoid the arrival of the bee.

The investment for the implementation of the mentioned technology is very important. However, we are convinced that it is the way, in addition to continuing to increase the area of seedless varieties.

In the approaching spring, the covered growing area will be larger so our supply of seedless fruit in 2022 will increase.

Along with the purchase of nets, machines have been acquired that carry out the placement and removal of them. In this way, the objectives of being more efficient in its implementation are achieved as well as extending the useful life of the net due to less manual handling.

We encourage that for subsequent campaigns, more producers and more surface area are added.

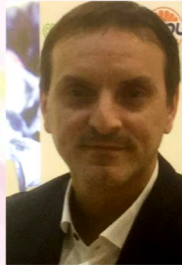
